- All animals must be leashed and with a current "Rabies Vaccination Certificate" available upon request

• Propane grills must be turned off at the tank when not in use. When in use, must be 10' or greater from any structure

• No grilling under canopy.

• Awnings must be 5 feet apart.

- All waste water to be piped to a sewer connection with no leaks to the ground surface
- All garbage must be in covered sealed bags and put in barrel
- All camping units are to be in designated areas only.
- No open fires
- REPORT: leaks, animal bites, illness, injuries and emergencies to Fair Office-518-561-7998 or EMS Building
- CAUTION: Electrical circuits are designated maximum of 30 amps at 110 volts only at old sites, and new sites at 50 amps at 110 volts.
- Storage of fuel, propane tanks, hay, paper, and other similar materials in direct sunlight may cause fire or explosion
- No horses in campsite grounds
- Quiet time in the Campground will be 11:00 PM
- **Only two (2) vehicles per campsite**
