GENERAL EXPLANTION

Anyone entering is subject to the following rules and regulations. All drivers must fill out an entry blank before taking part. Officials reserve the right to accept or reject any and all applications. Only drivers, owners and mechanics who sign the release sheet will be permitted in the pit area.

DRIVERS ENTRY

1. Driver must be at least 16 years of age and if less than 18 years of age must have a notarized minor's release signed by a parent or guardian. **Pit crew must be at least 15 years of age.**
2. All drivers must wear clean, long sleeved clothing.
3. Drivers and mechanics have an obligation to read the rules for their best interest. Drivers or pit crews not obeying these rules as well as all rules described at drivers' meeting prior to the Derby will be disqualified.
4. The conduct of drivers and/or crew can disqualify drivers from this and future events. There will be no finger gestures to anyone, fans or staff. There will be no arguing or fighting tolerated at all. If this happens you will be escorted off the fairgrounds, **and car will become property of fair.**
5. All cars must be removed from Fairground property by 6:00 AM, Friday, July 21, 2017 following the demo or they will become property of the Fair Association. Your cars are your responsibility, not the fair or demo personnel. If you leave it and something becomes missing, it's your fault.
6. **One driver and one mechanic per car will be allowed in with the entry fee.**

INSURANCE

1. ALL INJURIES MUST BE REPORTED TO OFFICIALS AT ONCE!

SAFETY AND CAR SPECIFICATIONS ALL EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES WILL BE CONSIDERED ILLEGAL

1. You must supply your own car. ALL CARS MUST BE STOCK – NO MODIFICATIONS.
2. All drivers must wear an approved helmet. A full-face helmet including a chin wrap around is recommended. Safety belts are required and must be buckled and a quick release chest restraining shoulder harness such as in any automobile must be used.
3. All glass side windows, rear windows, including headlights, parking lights and plastic tail lights must be removed.
4. All dirt and loose pieces must be swept out of car. REAR SEAT MUST BE REMOVED.
5. Stock gas tanks must be removed from original location. A three (3) or (6) gallon plastic maximum capacity gas tank must be mounted in front of the rear axle. Gas tanks must be in a **metal box with no foam or similar material will be allowed in the box.** No reserve tanks allowed. All caps, fittings and lines must be leak proof. One gas tank per car – NO switching gas tanks. 18 Inches of Separation between the gas tank and Battery
6. DOORS MUST BE CHAINED SHUT (NO WELDING), only one (1) chain per door. Hub caps, sharp hood ornaments and all chrome molding MUST BE REMOVED.
7. All hood and trunk hold-down springs must be removed or disconnected. Hoods may be bolted or chained down after inspection line. No welding. Same as trunk, only two (2) spots may be done. You must have hole cut for fire prevention.

8. The complete ignition switch may be relocated/moved/alterred, providing key or toggle switches replace ignition on/off and start switches. **ANY OPEN WIRING TO START VEHICLES IN DRIVER COMPARTMENT SHALL BE CALLED ILLEGAL.**
9. Cross members may be bolted or chained in, with no larger than three (3) inch washers. Drive shaft safety chain is optional.
10. All trailer hitches must be removed.
11. Driver side door panel and arm rest must be removed and padded with foam rubber. (You may use foam rubber from rear seat). All interior must be removed (dash optional).
12. Tires must be street legal, “no studs”. Snow treads, cut tires or all terrain tires will be permitted. Double tires allowed, tubes and air only.
13. Bumpers can be no higher than two (2) feet from ground level to top of bumper. Any stock production bumpers allowed as long as it is in stock location. If changed, bumpers **MUST BE BOLTED. NO WELDING!!**
14. **PROTEST:** \$25.00 must accompany each WRITTEN PROTEST and must be submitted to the official starter within THREE MINUTES of completion of the event. Protest must apply to winners only and pertain to a rule violation that, in the opinion of the officials, would give the car an advantage.
15. **CAR APPEARANCE:** You may have any number you want. CARS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO THE PIT AREA UNLESS ALL LETTERING OR SLOGANS ARE IN GOOD TASTE.
16. Three (3) point seat belt is mandatory.
17. Chrysler Imperials are allowed. No plating floor boards. Must have stock body mounts.

18. **YOU MUST HAVE WORKING BRAKES.** Car must be able to stop by using brake pedal.
19. Windshield strap.
20. Welded rear-ends are legal.
21. Batteries must be in a plastic or wooden box – **NO METAL BOXES ALLOWED.** They must be secured to the floor on the passenger side or in the original location. Battery must be covered.
22. Driver compartment cage recommended. May not support unibody or frame. Must be mounted to body only, not the frame.
23. No altering firewalls from stock locations. If any holes they will be covered with tin only. No access to motor area during derby. If caught, it will be an automatic disqualification.
24. Motors can be changed, but motor mounts must be in stock locations. **NO CRADLES.** Stock cylinders only for car.
25. There will be a Truck heat, entry fees paid by entrants. All money collected will be returned to class. Positions paid back by number of entries in class.
26. Only the driver of the car will be allowed on the track at any time. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** When the heat or feature is completed he is to stay with his car unless removed by officials. If anyone else, crew, fan, etc., is caught on the track they will be escorted off the grounds and the car disqualified.
27. **ONLY PEOPLE WITH STAGE PASSES WILL BE ALLOWED ON STAGE.** The only exception is, if you are a winner and you are coming to get your prize. **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A STAGE PASS, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE STAGE.**

28. IF YOU ARE ASKED TO LEAVE, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT BY THE SHERIFF AND YOUR CAR WILL NOT BE RUN BY ANYONE ELSE. YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

29. Cars must have stock body mounts. No extra body mounts allowed. If a car has a bad mount, it can be fixed with a max three (3) inch washer.

THIS IS INTENDED TO BE A FUN NIGHT OF DEMO AND ENTERTAINMENT

CARS ARE NOT TO BE WELDED UP. IF SOMETHING HAS TO BE CHANGED, IT MUST BE BOLTED ON. THIS GOES FOR THE V8 HEAT.

THE V8'S, TRUCKS AND Figure 8 drivers WILL RUN FOR THEIR OWN "POT" AND PRIZE MONEY WILL BE DETERMINED BY NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS.

THE V8'S, TRUCKS, Figure 8 drivers MUST BUY A PIT PASS AND SIGN WAIVER.

PARENTS OF KIDS IN THE POWER WHEELS MUST SIGN A CONSENT WAIVER.
