CONSIDERATIONS FOR JUDGING DOMESTIC ARTS!

1. ALL WORK MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR, FINISHED, CLEAN & NEATLY PRESSED
2. Only items submitted for the first time will be judged.
3. Pictures and wall hangings must be ready for hanging with well-attached hangers and edges
4. Hand sewing must be neat, uniform and as invisible as possible with seams and edges finished and trim accessories well attached.
5. Tracing, marking lines, loose ends, or threads should not be visible and the article should be knot free as possible.
6. If glue is used, it should be as invisible as possible.
7. Plastic canvas corners and edges need to be well covered and free from sharp edges.

ANY ARTICLE DEEMED BY THE JUDGES TO BE UNFIT FOR JUDGING WILL NOT BE JUDGED!

Please examine premium lists carefully and make entries in their proper division. Articles entered under the wrong name or division will not be judged.
