ALL ELIGIBLE ANIMALS BEING EXHIBITED AT THE CLINTON COUNTY FAIR MUST VACCINATED FOR RABIES WITHIN 365 DAYS PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FAIR.

It is preferable to establish rabies Immunity well in advance of the fair season. Keep In mind that an non-immunized animal (or an animal whose protective vaccination status has expired) exposed to rabies virus Prior to receiving its vaccination is not likely to be protected.

Exhibitors should consult with their veterinarian about vaccinating their animal(s) against rabies as soon as possible. As animals receive their booster vaccination a population will be forming that is protected against rabies to the broadest degree possible.

All out-of-state horses must be examined by an accredited veterinarian within ten days prior to entry into the state and must be accompanied by a certificate of equine examination signed by said veterinarian. The certificate must include the rectal temperature of the horse. Horses carrying a temperature of 102 degrees Fahrenheit or more are excluded from entry or exhibition.
